
PEOPLE

THE SECOND


MAJOR ELEMENT OF THE HTS



• VEHICLE


• MACHINES USED IN THE SYSTEM: CARS, TRUCKS, MOTORCYCLES, BICYCLES, ETC.

THE THIRD




ENVIRONMENT


PURPOSE OF THE HTS

NATURE OF THE DRIVING TASK


- DRIVING IS A SOCIAL TASK.
