TARGETING CONCEPTS



TARGETS

- Target Area-the driving environment to the left and right of the target
- Travel Path-the path the vehicle actually travels
- Targeting Path-the actual space you expect your car will be when you first see the target



WHY LEARN TARGET USAGE?

- HELPS DRIVERS TO VISUALIZE THE SPACE THEY INTEND TO OCCUPY.
- BEGIN TO USE A SEARCHING PROCESS.
- GETS THE DRIVER TO LOOK FAR AHEAD.
- ALLOWS THE DRIVER TO PLAN AHEAD
- INCREASES STEERING ACCURACY

What is a Target?

A target is a fixed object that appears in the center of the path you intend to drive
