


Approach the car


- Check the tires.
- Check for anything under the vehicle or near the tires.
- Check for posts or other obstacles near the car.
- Check for any damage or obvious fluid leaks.



What should you identify?




The rear tire is flat!




Door

- Store your belongings in the trunk.
- Get in the car.
- Lock your door.
- Driver check to make sure that all doors are locked.




Key

- Ask your instructor for the key.
- Insert the key in the ignition, but do not start the engine.




Adjust seat

- Move the seat with the lever under the front of the seat.
- Make sure you are at least 10 inches from the steering wheel.
- Adjust the seat back with the lever to the left of the seat.




Adjust seat

• Adjust the head restraint directly behind your head.



Adjust mirrors

• Adjust the inside mirror - center it on the rear window.



Adjust mirrors

• Adjust the left outside mirror -Move your head close to the window and just barely see the side of your car. Most have an inside adjustment lever.



Seatbelts

- Buckle your seatbeltlow and tight
- Make sure the shoulder belt goes over your shoulder
- Make sure everyone is buckled up
