## WHITE LINES



#### **SOLID WHITE**

- DO NOT CROSS
- USUALLY A FOG LINE ALONG THE RIGHT SIDE OF A ROADWAY
- MARKING THE EDGE OF THE TRAVEL PORTION OF A ROADWAY
- STAY TO THE LEFT OF THIS LINE

#### **BROKEN WHITE**

- SEPARATES TRAFFIC GOING IN THE SAME DIRECTION
- ONE WAY STREETS
- YOU MAY CROSS THIS LINE

#### WHITE DOTS

- LANE MARKERS
- HELPS GIVE DIRECTION OF LANE WHEN TURNING
- KEEP TO THE LEFT OF THIS LINE

#### **DOUBLE SOLID LINES**


- SEPARATES TRAFFIC GOING IN THE SAME DIRECTION
- BOTH LANES OF TRAFFIC CANNOT CROSS

#### **BARRIER LINE**

- TREAT THIS LINE AS IF IT WERE A CONCRETE BARRIER
- DO NOT CROSS
- THIS LINE IS TWICE AS WIDE AS A NORMAL LANE LINE.

#### **YELLOW LINES**

• ALWAYS KEEP TO THE RIGHT OF A YELLOW LINE



#### **SOLID YELLOW LINE**

- SEPARATES TRAFFIC GOING IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS
- KEEP TO THE RIGHT OF THIS LINE
- DO NOT CROSS
- EXCEPT WHEN TURNING LEFT OFF OF THE ROADWAY

#### **BROKEN YELLOW LINES**

- SEPARATES TRAFFIC GOING IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS
- BOTH DIRECTIONS MAY CROSS THIS LINE
- PASSING IS PERMITTED

## DOUBLE SOLID YELLOW LINES

- SEPARATES TRAFFIC GOING IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS
- KEEP TO THE RIGHT
- BOTH DIRECTIONS OF TRAFFIC MAY NOT CROSS
- BOTH DIRECTIONS CANNOT PASS
- LEFT TURNS FROM ROADWAY PERMITTED

## SOLID YELLOW WITH A YELLOW BROKEN LINE

- TRAFFIC WITH THE SOLID LINE CANNOT PASS
- TRAFFIC WITH THE BROKEN LINE MAY PAS

#### YELLOW DOTS

- SEPARATES TRAFFIC GOING IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS
- LANE GUIDE MARKERS
- KEEP TO THE RIGHT OF THIS LINE

#### **DOUBLE BROKEN**

• THESE ARE REVERSIBLE LANE LINES
