SBAC Testing

This is the time of year when students have the opportunity to demonstrate proficiency in English/Language Arts, Math, and Science. Our tenth graders will take the Smarter Balanced Assessment in English Language Arts, and some juniors who did not meet standard last year will also participate in this test. Our juniors will take the Smarter Balanced Assessment in math, and students will be participating in End of Course Assessments in Algebra, Geometry, and Biology. During this time attendance is the key to success. Please encourage your student to come to school rested and ready to go. Testing will take place starting on May 15th and ending on June 7th.
