 - **Many bridges are narrower than the roadway including shoulders**



Bridges

- The potential dangers in crossing bridges:
 - Many bridges are narrower than the roadway including shoulders
 - **Bridges tend to frost over before other parts of the roadway**




Bridges

CAUTION:

- **You should not stop or park your vehicle on bridges except in extreme emergency.**

Bridges

- Even if you should have a blowout on a narrow bridge, **DON'T STOP!**




Bridges

CAUTION:

- **-Drive slowly off the bridge until you can get your car completely onto the shoulder, out of the travel lane.**

- Because of narrowness and barricades to each side, you will not have alternate lane positions.



Bridges

- Because of narrowness and barricades to each side, you will not have alternate lane positions.

Therefore, make an extra effort to separate risks by not being on the bridge while meeting other traffic, **especially large trucks.**
